

As of this writing, on May 17,2021, COVID-19 cases are quickly declining, mostly as a result of massive immunization, and measures such as mask wearing, social distancing and hand washing.

The CDC has stated that if you are fully vaccinated, you may elect to not wear a mask in indoor or outdoor locations. There is still a rare chance you can get infected, but symptoms should be mild or negligible, and there is even a less chance that you can pass it to others if you are fully vaccinated.

TO BE CLEAR, DR. KLUCKA STRONGLY URGES ALL PATIENTS TO GET VACCINATED, TO PROTECT THEMSELVES AND THEIR FAMILIES.

Since we still have immunodeficient patients using our office, and many of our patients and personnel are still not fully vaccinated, **WE STILL REQUIRE THAT YOU WEAR A MASK WHILE IN OUR OFFICE**, and your temperature will be taken when entering. This policy is in a state of flux, however, and if case prevalence falls to 3% or less in Lee and Charlotte Counties, or we achieve herd immunity soon, these measures may be lifted.
